

Price Electric Cooperative responded to a ROPE (Restoration of Power in an Emergency) request issued by Freeborn-Mower Cooperative Services in Albert Lea, MN. Thirty-six counties were included in an emergency order issued by Minnesota governor Tim Walz last week due to damage caused by Winter Storm Wesley across southern Minnesota that were previously affected by flooding. The storm created blizzard conditions in the area, causing road closures and extensive damage to the electrical distribution system. Freeborn-Mower alone lost 500 poles to this storm. Price Electric journeyman lineman Mark Pomeroy and apprentice Casey Williams departed Phillips on the afternoon of Friday, April 12 to assist in the restoration of power.
