How Were the New Rates Determined?

A Rate and Cost of Service Study was conducted by the engineering firm of Power Systems Engineering. This study was utilized to establish a rate design that determines the minimum revenue needed to meet the Cooperative's financial obligations while ensuring that no one rate class is subsidizing another.
