



Frequently Asked Questions

Will any equipment be connected to my home?

All equipment will be installed next to and interconnected with the Cooperative's electric grid on Springs Drive south of Phillips. The power generated will be primarily utilized by PEC's facility, with the remainder being utilized by members connected to the grid. Members participating in the program will receive a bill credit based on the amount of electricity generated.

Do I need to pay the full cost of the solar subscription upfront, or can I pay in installments?

The full subscription cost of \$750 per panel will need to be paid at the time the agreement is made.

How many subscriptions can I purchase?

Each PEC member may purchase up to two (2) panel subscriptions.

Can the general public purchase subscriptions?

Subscriptions are available only to active PEC members. Any electric generation from the member's subscribed panel(s) will be credited to the member's monthly electric bill.

How much will a 400-watt panel generate?

Subscribers will be credited with the actual generation for the month in question. Credits are estimated to be \$3-\$10 month or 25-62 kWhs.

Why is Price Electric building a solar garden?

Because of the interest expressed by members and to offer our members local energy generation alternatives that reduce emission pollutants, provide potential bill relief, and deliver energy into the distribution system to reduce demand while consuming it at your member service center.

How do I participate in PEC's solar garden?

You will need to sign a Solar Subscription Agreement and make a one-time payment for the number of panel subscriptions you would like to purchase.



Where is the PEC Solar Garden located?

The solar array is located east of PEC's Member Service Center on Springs Drive in Phillips. The solar garden's interconnection with the existing utility grid will allow the generated power to be used by the PEC Member Service Center whenever possible, and distributed to members connected to the grid. Members can benefit from the clean energy generated and the bill credits from generation.

PEC Solar Array Facts:

- The array includes 272 400-watt rated panels.
- The unique bi-facial design of the panels will allow the array to maximize solar absorption throughout the day, at a rate of 10-20% more than monofacial panels.
- The solar array has an estimated life expectancy of 20 years, which is the length of the member subscription agreement.
- Solar panels produce electricity even on cloudy days, usually around 10-20% of the amount produced on sunny days. Even in months with less sun, members participating should expect to receive a bill credit.
